

The narrator's kin at Combray (and some in Paris)

In *Combray* 1 and 2 and *Swann in Love*, M's kin are slowly revealed.

All are on Mama's side of the family. There seems to be no mention of Father's side throughout the entire Search.

Grandmother (Bathilde) is Mama's mother.

Grandfather (Amédée) is Mama's father. (So she is Mme Amedee.)

Grandmother has two unmarried sisters: Céline and Flora. Sometimes referred to as "aunts" – but technically great-aunts.

"My great-aunt" - technically Grandfather's cousin, but called "my great-aunt".

("My grandfather's cousin - by courtesy my great-aunt - was the mother of ... Aunt Leonie." SW, p 66.2 - Mod Lib.)

Aunt Léonie is the daughter of "my great-aunt."

Aunt Léonie is the widow of uncle Octave. (So she is Mme Octave.)

Adolphe - Grandfather's brother. Sometimes referred to as "uncle" but technically, he is great-uncle.
